The purpose of such a meeting would be to resolve and determine if further action by this office is warranted.

If there is no resolution of the complaint and there is a violation of the Order, the Friend of the Court may schedule a hearing before either a referee or a circuit judge. Domestic relations mediation is also available through the Friend of the Court to resolve the dispute upon the agreement of both parties.
