NEW ROAD IMPROVEMENT MILLAGE RENEWAL OF TAX RATE FOR ROAD IMPROVEMENT

Shall the limitation on the total amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in the Township of Chassell be increased to 2 mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value), which will result in tax revenue collections to be \$160,741.66 in the first year for a period of four (4) years, being 2025 through 2028; said revenues to be used exclusively for road improvement within Chassell Township.
